SNOW DAYS, LATE STARTS, and EARLY DISMISSALS

Make sure your phone numbers are up to date for the One Call Now system. Unpredictable winter weather can cause a school cancellation or delay. Make sure your students know what to do if school is dismissed early.

WE ARE SEEING LOTS OF SICK KIDS IN THE CLINIC-HOW CAN YOU HELP?

1. If your child is sick, stay home. No fever, vomiting, or diarrhea for 24 hours.
2. **PLEASE, CALL THE OFFICE AND LET US KNOW WHEN YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT!**
3. **IF YOUR CHILD'S ABSENCE IS NOT REPORTED, IT WILL BE UNEXCUSED.**
4. Teach your child to cough and sneeze properly. Kids can pull their shirt out and sneeze or cough into it to help prevent the virus from spreading. Coughing into your elbow works too.
5. Tell children not to touch their faces (eyes, mouth, or nose) or kiss anybody on the face.
6. Wash your hands after coughing, blowing your nose, or sneezing. Immediately throw tissues away. Don't leave them laying around.
7. Wash your hands before touching your face or eating anything. Scrub at least 30 seconds.
8. To prevent the flu from spreading, clean and spray Lysol on everything. Spray Lysol on your child's book bag. Wash their coat, clothes, and bedding.
